- ✧ A dance or duffel bag (for your stuff)
- ✧ A small writing tablet and pencils to jot down costume items, choreo, and info regarding the dances and region you are learning
- ✧ An unused CD (some maestros will burn the music—take advantage & appreciate their generosity)
- ✧ Damas— HAIR IN A BUN— no loose hair!
- ✧ Camera to take photos of costumes and other items
- ✧ Tennis shoes. **NO flipflops or sandals!**

Wear suitable workout gear: sweat pants, T-shirts, sweat shorts. ABSOLUTELY NO Jeans, skirts.

workshop EXPECTATIONS and RESPONSIBILITIES

1. You represent our group.
2. Respect your maestros → Give your full attention and respect at all times.
3. Absolutely no talking during class instruction.
4. Don't be afraid to ask clear, concise questions.
5. Go to the FRONT line to learn—Don't hold back. Maestros will see your interest and will appreciate your enthusiasm. Some maestros switch lines, some will not— so, don't “establish” yourself in the back line.
6. Meet other dancers! Smile, be courteous, and introduce yourselves.

8. Behave, Be enthusiastic, Be happy! Enjoy!!

- # Merge onto I-580 W - go 19.53mi
- # Take the SAN JOSE/SACRAMENTO exit onto I-680 S toward SAN JO - go 29.84 mi
- # Take the LOS ANGELES/SAN FRAN exit onto US-101 S toward LA ... - go 6.8 mi
- # Take the SILVER CREEK VALLEY RD (CA-82)/BLOSSOM HILL RD exit- go 0.30 mi
- # Turn Right on BLOSSOM HILL RD(CR-G10 W)
- # Take ramp toward MONTEREY RD/CA-82 - go 0.20 mi
- # Turn Right on MONTEREY RD(CA-82 N) - go 0.10 mi
- # Continue to follow CA-82 N - go 0.30 mi
- # Turn Left on CHYNOWETH AVE - go 0.60 mi
- # Turn Right on EDENVALE AVE - go 0.30 mi
- # Arrive at 200 EDENVALE AVE, SAN JOSE, on the Left

FROM HAYES TO EVERGREEN COLLEGE

- # Start at 200 EDENVALE AVE going toward RED RIVER WAY - go 0.30 mi
- # Turn Left on CHYNOWETH AVE - go 0.50 mi
- # Turn Right on MONTEREY HWY(CA-82 S) - go 0.10 mi
- # Continue to follow CA-82 S - go 0.50 mi
- # Take ramp onto BLOSSOM HILL RD(CR-G10 E) - go 0.50 mi
- # Continue on SILVER CREEK VALLEY RD - go 3.86 mi
- # Turn Right on YERBA BUENA RD - go 0.81 mi
- # Bear Right on YERBA BUENA RD - go 0.60 mi
- # Make a U-Turn at VALLE DEL LAGO onto YERBA BUENA RD - go 0.1 mi
- # Arrive at 3095 YERBA BUENA RD, SAN JOSE, on the Right

FROM EVERGREEN COLLEGE TO SAC

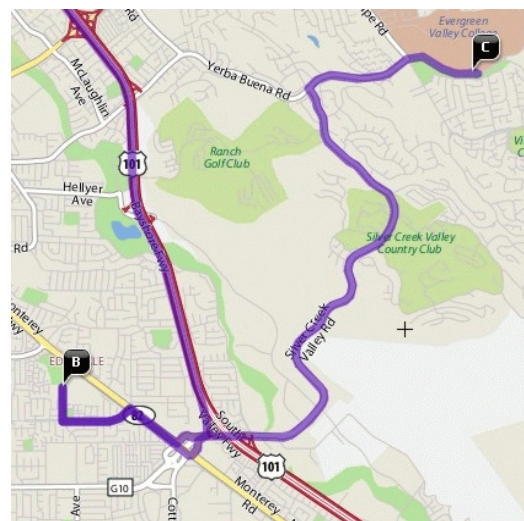
- # Start at 3095 YERBA BUENA RD, going toward SAN FELIPE RD - go 0.50 mi
- # Turn Right on SAN FELIPE RD - go 1.52 mi
- # Bear Left on ABORN RD - go 0.91 mi
- # Turn Right on E CAPITOL EXPY - go 3.76 mi
- # Take ramp onto I-680 N - go 27.94 mi
- # Take exit #30/LIVERMORE/STOCKTON onto I-580 E
toward STOCKTON ... - go 20.13 mi
- # Take Left fork onto I-205 E toward TRACY/STOCKTON - go 13.52 mi
- # Exit onto I-5 N - go 49.48 mi

FROM SAC TO RADISSON

- # Turn Right to take ramp onto I-5 S toward STOCKTON - go 48.17 mi
- # Take exit #458B/SAN FRANCISCO onto I-205 W - go 14.02 mi
- # Merge onto I-580 W - go 19.53 mi
- # Take the SAN JOSE/SACRAMENTO exit onto I-680 S toward SAN JOSE - go 17.52 mi
- # Take exit #12/MISSION BLVD onto MISSION BLVD(CA-262 W) toward MISSION
BLVD WEST/WARM SPRINGS DISTRICT (I-880)/UC EXTENSION - go 1.21 mi
- # Take Left ramp onto I-880 S toward SAN JOSE - go 9.11 mi
- # Take exit #4A/DOWNTOWN/N FIRST ST - go 0.20 mi
- # Turn Right on N 1ST ST - go 0.20 mi
- # Turn Right on E GISH RD - go 0.20 mi
- # Turn Left on N 4TH ST - go 0.10 mi
- # Arrive at 1471 N 4TH ST, SAN JOSE,

FROM RADISSON TO EVERGREEN COLLEGE

- # Start at 1471 N 4TH ST, SAN JOSE going toward KOLL CIR - go 0.40 mi
- # Make a Sharp Right Turn to take ramp onto US-101 S toward LOS ANGELES - go 10.31 mi
- # Take the SILVER CREEK VALLEY RD (CA-82)/BLOSSOM HILL RD exit - go 0.30 mi
- # Turn Right on BLOSSOM HILL RD(CR-G10 W)
- # Take ramp toward MONTEREY RD/CA-82 - go 0.20 mi
- # Turn Right on MONTEREY RD(CA-82 N) - go 0.10 mi
- # Continue to follow CA-82 N - go 0.30 mi
- # Turn Left on CHYNOWETH AVE - go 0.60 mi

WISHLIST

Taking advantage of the DUF Mercado—costumes, footwear, accessories, & music!

It is difficult to ignore the many items displayed for your purchasing pleasure. However, to appreciate, *post-DUF*, the purchases you make during DUF jot down a list of the items *you need*. It's okay to walk away with *maracas*, ceramics, and a headdress *if you already* bought the *arracadas*, the boots, red *paleacate*, and the *sombrero* you may need. Before you go to DUF and shop, don't forget to take a peak online—just to make sure that the items you are purchasing are truly a good buy.

What do you lack to perform? Do you want your own Veracruz or Nayarit costume? Damas—those white boots? —they are a must have!

“No Excuse” Basics

- Damas: black folklorico shoes
 white folklorico shoes
 white folklorico boots
 arracadas (don't go too small)*
 red paleacate
 rebozo (don't buy short ones)*
 bloomers
- Boys: white boots
 black boots
 white pants for Veracruz
 black pants for Nuevo Leon
 gold ring for Veracruz*
 red paleacate
charro belt – see below

*Because we think our dhild dancer is “little” we decide to purchase the little rebozo and little arracadas– but, within in a year they have outgrown them! Rebozo should be adult size and arracadas, at least MEDIUM size.
